What Is the Veteran ID?

The Fayette County Veteran ID Card is a free photo ID for honorably discharged veterans. It provides proof of service can be used to receive discounts at participating businesses

Step-by-Step Instructions

- 1 Gather Documentation**
Bring your DD 214 or NGB-22
(must show honorable discharge)
- 2 Visit the Recorder of Deeds Office**
61 E Main Street Uniontown, PA
- 3 Take Your Photo**
Photos taken on-site
- 4 Get Your ID Card**
Includes holographic security and is valid at local businesses
